I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

"RUBY" exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on the evening of 10 December 2014.

II. AFFECTED POPULATION (Tab A)

- A total of **902,291 families / 3,852,672 persons** were affected in Regions III, IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, VIII, CARAGA and NCR
- A total of **31,528 families / 164,054 persons** are currently being served inside and outside **459 evacuation centers**

III. CASUALTIES (Tab B)

- **Eighteen (18) deaths** were reported in Regions IV-A, IV-B, VI, VII, and VIII
- A total of **916 injured persons** were reported in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, and VIII

IV. STATUS OF LIFELINES

Power

- Power are now restored except in the Provinces of Western Samar, Northern Samar, and Eastern Samar

Telecommunications

- **98.87%** of PLDT, DIGITEL, SMART and SUN cellsites were restored in affected areas in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, and VIII
- Globe network is **88.01%** restored in the affected areas in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, and VIII

V. ROADS AND BRIDGES

- **All roads and bridges are now passable**

VI. CLASS SUSPENSION

- Classes have resumed except in the Cities of Borongan and Catbalogan

VII. DAMAGED HOUSES (TAB C)

- A total of **253,424 damaged houses** were reported in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, VIII, and CARAGA, in which **39,384 were totally damaged** and **214,040 were partially damaged**

VIII. COST OF DAMAGES (Tab D)

- A total of **₱3,349,359,620.00** worth of damages in infrastructure and agriculture was reported in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, and VIII

Infrastructure : ₱1,435,804,523.00

Agriculture : ₱1,913,555,097.00
