Gaurav Ganti

is a mechanical engineer, who has specialised in renewable systems design, and currently works as a climate policy analyst at Climate Analytics. He co-authored the report »Global and regional coal phase-out requirements of the Paris Agreement: Insights from the IPCC Special Report on 1.5°C«. Climate Analytics aims to provide advanced science and policy analysis in the field of climate change to support science-based policy across the globe.

Magnus Hornø Gottlieb

is a Senior Global Public Affairs Advisor at Ørsted. Ørsted has undergone a transformation from a coal and oil intensive energy company to a global market leader in offshore wind and one of the largest renewable energy companies in the world that plans to phase out coal by 2023.

Sara Goulartt

is the Head of Climate and Environment at the Portuguese energy EDP-Energias de Portugal. The company is the largest electricity generator in Portugal, the third in the Iberian Peninsula and the fifth largest private group in Brazil, while EDP Renewables is the world's third-largest wind energy producer. At the start of this year EDP announced the closure of its 1,296 MW Sines coal plant, putting Portugal on track to become coal free by end of 2021.

Charles Moore

works as European Programme Lead at Ember. He produces analysis and develops strategies to support Ember's policy goals with a specific focus on European coal phase-out. He is an experienced utility professional, who joined Ember in 2017 after spending 5 years at RWE in a variety of roles across the electricity and natural gas value chain.
